

GGF GREEN ACADEMY - TRAINING SPONSORSHIP PROGRAMME



THE GGF GREEN ACADEMY PROVIDES CAPACITY-BUILDING AND SUPPORTS GGF PARTNERS IN ENHANCING THEIR KNOWLEDGE ON TOPICS AROUND SUSTAINABILITY, RENEWABLE ENERGY AND RESOURCE EFFICIENCY. AS PART OF THE GREEN ACADEMY PARTNERS CAN APPLY FOR SPONSORSHIPS

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. Managers of your institution discuss staff training needs with the **GGF contact person**.
2. Together they select the most suitable training course (in-house, external, online, conference, etc.), as well as the eligible participant(s).
3. The participant(s) submits a motivation letter¹ to the GGF TAF.
4. If the participation has been approved, the GGF TAF sends a confirmation letter.
5. The institution proceeds with registering for the training and making travel and accommodation arrangements.

WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

The GGF Technical Assistance Facility (TAF) funds 100% of the tuition costs; the beneficiary will cover the related travel and accommodation costs of its staff as well as other logistic costs, if applicable. For participation at conferences, TAF finances 100% of a conference fee, while travel and accommodation costs will be covered by the beneficiary.

The maximum cumulative contribution for training sponsorships and conferences is limited to a total of EUR 10,000 per institution per year. In addition, the maximum number of events an institution can apply for is 3 (training and/or conferences and/or study visits) per institution per year.
